

BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING MINUTES March 27, 2015 10:00 a.m. Venus, Florida

- I. Call to Order by Gary Howalt **10:10** a.m.
 - a. Roll call by sign in sheet See attached sign in sheet.

 - d. Responsibility for the Technical Program Documentation Gregg Jones volunteered to prepare the meeting summary.
- II. Election of Executive Committee Members

A motion to nominate Jeremy McBryan for the Secretary position was approved by the Board. A motion to elect the following officers was approved by the Board: Gary Howalt (President); Kristin Bennett (Vice-President); Mark Diblin (Treasurer); Jeremy McBryan, Secretary. Kristin Bennett emphasized the need to start recruiting the next Treasurer as Mark Diblin's term will end December 2015.

 - a. Presentation of February 2015 Board of Directors Meeting Minutes Kristin Bennett A motion to approve the draft February 2015 Board of Directors Meeting minutes as submitted was approved.
 - b. Presentation of Treasurer Report Mark Diblin
 A financial Summary for Jan. 1 Mar. 26, 2015 was provided (see attached report):
 Total income: \$10,410; Net expenses: \$9,578. Mark also mentioned that approximately \$1,000 of revenue from the 24th Annual Southwest Florida Water Resources Conference held in Feb. 2015 will be donated to AWRA Florida. Rosanne Clementi suggested that this amount be reserved for poster contest awards or student travel to future Southwest Florida Water Resources Conferences. The education committee will provide a recommendation to the board at a future board meeting. A motion to accept the Treasurer's report as submitted was approved.

 - i. Education Rosanne Clementi
 - Kristin Bennett reviewed the scholarships and grants that are available and reminded attendees that AWRA National again donated 6 complimentary student registrations to the 2015 AWRA Annual Water Resources Conference. Two applications have been received to date. Deadline for all applications is May 15, 2015. Rosanne mentioned that the High School Scholarship does not yet have a name associated with it and made a motion to name it in honor of Laura and Buddy Blain. Kristin suggested that someone communicate with the Blain's to ensure that they are supportive. Garrett Wallace suggested that Doug Manson could assist as he visits with the Blain's weekly.

 - Gregg asked if we are doing all we can to solicit meeting and newsletter sponsors as this information typically not available or very limited during newsletter preparation activities. The board discussed the need to prepare a draft policy that attempts to clarify how best to add/increase sponsorship of our newsletter and provide a framework for deciding what content from businesses/organizations should be added to our newsletter as information and what content can be added upon donation/sponsorship. Gregg volunteered to assist with increasing meeting

sponsorships. Discussion on the need to distribute the newsletter at least 30 days before the next technical meeting also occurred. AWRA National Board of Directors Travel Policy

December 8, 2014

It is the policy of the Florida Section of the American Water Resources Association (AWRA Florida) to aid in attendance and travel costs for active members of AWRA Florida who serve on the Board of Directors of the American Water Resources Association (AWRA National). Preference will be given to AWRA Florida members who serve on the AWRA Florida Board of Directors (Board) or who are otherwise very active in AWRA Florida.

The Board has budgeted up to \$1,500 annually to aid in travel costs associated with AWRA National meetings/conferences. Costs will be reimbursed for meeting/conference registration, lodging and airfare. In the event of multiple requests for travel funds, the Board will discuss the merit of each request and disperse the funds appropriately.

A request for reimbursement must be made two months prior to travel. Board members requesting approval for reimbursement of travel costs must abstain from voting on the issue.

This policy shall remain in effect until authorized changes of the Board of the Florida Section of AWRA.
